The Queensbury Central Volunteer Fire Company has been serving Queensbury residents since 1947. Through the continued efforts of our volunteers, this community enjoys a relatively low cost for fire protection. Training, education, and unselfish dedication continue to be the driving force in providing the highest level of integrity and customer service when our services are called upon.

Based on current activity, the fire company is projected to respond to over 1,200 calls for service during this calendar year. This service can range from commercial or residential structure incidents, motor vehicle accidents, or cardiac arrest. The Queensbury Central Volunteer Fire Company provides continuous Emergency Medical Services First Response within the protection district. These calls for service do not include the thousands of hours spent on fire prevention, public education, and training that each member participates in for continued service to the citizens of Queensbury.

It is imperative that the members remain on the cutting edge of technology, education, and advances in the fields of construction, vehicle assembly, and medical protocols. This training and education requires upgrades in equipment and systems to remain current. Although funding is provided under a contract with the Town of Queensbury, there is always a need for extra income to permit us to retain this competitive edge and to fund programs not covered under the town contract.
